## Case of Smt. KIRAN PRAKASH SINGH

This matter was mentioned by the applicant for urgent intervention, and accordingly taken up.

Applicant is the owner of the property in question by virtue of court's decree upto the High Court stage. The property, however, has been recently purportedly sold by the applicant's mother-in-law on misrepresentation inter alia of the fact that she is the owner. Right to property may be at the root of the matter but justice demands that status quo should be maintained till the applicant seeks her remedy in court of law, as she may be advised, lest in the event of the vendee taking forcible possession – resulting in applicant's dispossession – it will only make situation complicated. Needless to say that it is the duty of the police to protect the property of any individual who has got decree in his/her favour. Besides, the applicant being a widow having a grown-up daughter, needs police protection.
