Subject: Non-payment and up-gradation of salaries to the Madrasa teachers in accordance with 6th Pay Revision.

In 'Inquilab', Urdu newspaper a news-item has appeared on 10.7.2014. According to this report in March 2014 the government declared that teachers of Madrasas will be paid their salaries in accordance with the 6th Pay Commission grades but this announcement and decision instead of bringing happiness to the teachers and their families has brought sorrows. For the last four months these teachers have not been paid their salaries at all on the ground that they will only get their salaries after all teachers' salaries are re-fixed under 6th Pay Commission. Even normally the fixation of salary under new scales should not take such a long time and even if it had taken time the teachers could be paid according to the earlier scales and later on arrears could be drawn in their favour. But they cannot be deprived of their salaries for four months.

Therefore, Principal Secretary, Education Department and Director, Education to give reports to this Commission within ten days.

The order should be sent immediately by the office.
