Case of shortage of teachers in LNMU College

Deputy Director, Higher Education present.

On 26 December 2014 a newspaper reported that there is a college L.N. Mithila University at Darbhanga. It has 3,000 students pursuing courses of different disciplines and there are only two teachers to take care of the all these students. A notice was issued to Director, Higher Education.

Deputy Director, Higher Education is present. He submitted that earlier also report was sent to the Commission. The office will try to locate the report. According to this report filed today it is confirmed that there are only two teachers. It is submitted that there are 22 posts in the college. That means that the college is being run on 9% strength of teachers. This is manifestly playing with the future and career of the students who are admitted in this college. This is shameful and needs immediate attention of the Government. The government should consider providing sufficient teachers. If it is not possible by appointment immediately, they can withdraw teachers from colleges where there are more than enough and post them in this college.

The Principal Secretary shall appear in person on the next date to apprise the Commission about the issue. The P. Secretary shall also file a

detailed report with respect to the educational institutions which have a teacher strength of less than 60% at present.

This report shall be filed within six weeks.
